



Charles Victor Demeter

December 27, 1941 - June 9, 2018

CORPUS CHRISTI – Charles Victor Demeter, 76, left to be with the Lord on Saturday, June 9, 2018 at in Corpus Christi, Texas. He was born on December 27, 1941 to Victoria and Charles “Blackie” Demeter in Sullivan City, Texas. The family doctor, Dr. Riley, wanted his middle name to be Victory since he was bor 20 days after the attack of Pearl Harbor but his parents decided to name him after his uncle, Victor Demeter. Charlie graduated from La Joya High School in 1960 and from Pan American Collage in May of 1966 with a major in Industrial Arts and a minor in Secondary Mathematics. He moved to Jamestown, N.Y. in june of 1966 and worked at Crawford Furniture Company as a designer and time study man. Charlie returned to La Joya, Texas in 1968 and taught High School Mathematics until 1971 when he left the teaching profession and went to work for Holzen Construction Company from Edinburg, Texas as a constrution superintendent until August 27, 1985 at that time he returned to the La Joya School District and served as Facilities Director, being responsible for the overseeing of the construction of 25 school campuses and also the maintenance of all school campuses. Charlie oversaw the actions of all pernnel for the support services departments, approximately 400 employees until his retirement in June 2007. He continued to reside in La Joya until moving to Corpus Christi in 2008, where he was closer to his family. Mr. Demeter is preceded in death by his parents Charles demeter and Victoria Mendiola Demeter; his sister Shirley Demeter and his nephew Ronald Hemmis.

Mr. Demeter is survived by his sister, Patsy Hemmis; his niece, Shirley Soto, her husband Alberto and their son Judd, along with numerous cousins and friends.

Family will be receiving friends today Monday, June 11, 2018 from 3:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. with a rosary recited at 7:00 p.m. at the Lord and I Funeral Home in Penitas, Texas. Funeral Mass will be held at 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, June 12, 2018 at Our Lady Queen of Angels Catholic Church in La Joya, Texas. Interment will follow to Lakeview Cemetery in La Joya, Texas.
