MCALLEN- Everett John Johnson, 90, left to be with the Lord on Sunday, January 11, 2015 at McAllen Medical Center in McAllen. He was born to John Edward Johnson and Martha Lucille Spanier on May 19, 1924 in Williams, Iowa. Mr. Johnson married his wife, Dorothy Anne Hackbarth on August 21, 1945 in Vernon Township, Wright County, Iowa, and were happily married for 59 years. Everett was a WWII veteran having served in the Marine Corps as part of the 7th Service Regiment during the occupation of China and a life member of the VFW. He worked for the State of Iowa Department of Transportation until his retirement in 1987. Following his retirement, Everett and his wife, Dorothy, were Winter Texans for several years and moved permanently to Rio Grande Valley in 2002.
