Verner Joseph Schneider, age 91, of McAllen, TX. formally of Shawano, WI., passed away at home peacefully on May 13th, 2022, surrounded by loved ones from near and far.

Born on April 19th, 1931 in Mt. Calvary, WI., on the family farm, the son of the late Alois and Gertrude (Nett) Schneider.

Vern served his country in the U.S. Navy from 1950 to 1954 during the Korean Conflict.

Vern married Joan R. Francart on September 19th, 1952 at Green Lake, WI. They raised 10 children in Neenah until 1969 when they moved to Bowler to manage the family farm owned by Grandpa Harold. In 1972 they moved to Shawano. Vern worked many part time jobs in his younger years to provide for his large family while continuing to work at the U.S. Post Office for 30 plus years in Neenah and Shawano, retiring in 1986, to McAllen, TX. They were winter Texans, traveling back to WI. to stay with their children in the summer months, visiting family and friends. 1999 was the last summer staying in Wisconsin. They were now official Texans.

Vern enjoyed hunting and fishing, cutting firewood with his grandchildren, playing accordion, singing songs with his "Leibchen" and his family, listening to old time country music, watching Molly B. Polka, playing Sheepshead, cribbage, and a marble board game.
